English

Writing composition

- Discuss and record ideas
- Compose and rehearse sentences orally
- Organise paragraphs around a theme
- Proof-read for spelling and punctuation errors

Spelling

- Spell words that are often misspelt
- Write from memory simple sentences

Vocabulary, Grammar and Punctuation

- Choose nouns or pronouns appropriately
- Use conjunctions, prepositions, adverbs, commas and fronted adverbials appropriately

Reading

- Read further exception words
- Increase familiarity with a wide range of books
- Check that the text makes sense, discuss understanding and explain the meaning of words in context
- Ask questions to improve understanding
- Retrieve and record information from non-fiction

ICT

- Create an autobiography using PowerPoint
- Understand E-Safety
- Use search technologies safely

To explore how lines are used to create effect in artwork

Math

Number and Place Value

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- Add and subtract numbers mentally
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number
- Order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000

Measure

- Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths, mass and volume/capacity

Fractions:

- Count up and down in tenths
- Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects
- Recognise and use fractions as numbers
- Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator within one whole
- Compare and order unit fractions
