Dana Al Anzy, our former Al Jazeera Academy student, was nominated and has now received a most prestigious award. His Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al-Thani presented Dana with the Gold Medal – the National Award for Academic Excellence in 2013 and now again 2018. Amongst her successes Dana was a speaker at the WISE Conference in Doha last Autumn (World Innovation Summit for Education.) She has attended Georgetown University and was in New York for the 71st session of the United Nations General Assembly. This organization aims to build a global movement that contributes to human, social and economic development through the provision of quality education. The initiative particularly focuses on the needs of children, women and the youth affected by poverty, conflict and disaster and aims to empower them to become active community members.
